



RRTO Induction Standard 11—Surface

Upon the successful completion of this training, participants obtain a credit card sized ID Card which indicates partial completion of Standard 11 Mine Induction. The participant can present this card at a recognising Qld mine site and be site inducted. In order to gain full completion of Standard 11 the participant is required to complete workplace assessments at the mine site.

This is highly interactive scenario based program delivering the underpinning knowledge for the following units

- RIICOM201D: Communicate in the workplace
- RIIGOV201D: Comply with site work processes / procedures
- RIIWHS201D: Work safely and follow OHS policies and procedures
- RIIRIS201D: Conduct local risk control
- RIIERR205D: Apply initial response First Aid
- RIIERR302D: Respond to local emergencies and incidents

To gain a Statement of Attainment the participant will need to complete an on-site verification booklet (provided in training) and provide the completed participant checklist and documentary evidence as per Participant Site Verification Booklet to Industry Training QLD and then be issued with a completion credit card sized ID Card.
