



# **AHCMOM216 Operate Side by Side Utility Vehicles and AHCMOM217 Operate Quad Bikes**



## **COURSE OVERVIEW**

These units of competency are designed for participants wanting to develop their knowledge and skills in maintaining and operating quad bikes. They include pre-operational checks, maintenance and operating equipment as per the Manufacturer's Operation Manual. These units apply to the following workers who use side by quad bikes as part of their day-to-day work:

- Agriculture
- Horticulture
- Land management
- Mining sectors
- Council workers
- Farmers, Graziers

## **Operate Quad Bike**

This unit covers the process of maintaining and operating quad bikes (four wheeled), and defines the standard required to: perform routine pre-operational checks and maintenance; match, attach and operate equipment as described in the manufacturer's operators manual; recognise and control hazards and risks; safely operate quad bikes in a range of weather and terrain conditions; monitor and maintain vehicle records.

### **Course Duration:**

This is a seven-hour course including theory and practical.
