WORK SAFELY AT HEIGHTS



COURSE OVERVIEW

This nationally recognised course is designed for persons who are required to work at heights. In this course, you will learn the risks (dangers) of working at heights. You will learn the best way to control the risk to make sure everyone is safe.

This course is based on materials from Australian Standards 1891 (Industrial Fall Arrest Systems), AS 2626 (Industrial Safety Belts and Harness Selection, use and maintenance), AS 4626 (Industrial Fall Arrest Device selection, use and maintenance) and the Code of Practice – Safe Working from Roofs and Industry specific competency. The above standards are to be used as guides in implementing a safe working at heights programme. Tailored training programmes are available that are targeted to specific needs based on risk assessments.

What will you learn?

- Apply legislative, organisation and site requirements and procedures
- Access, interpret and apply technical and safety information
- Apply diagnostic/fault-finding techniques
- Apply environmental requirements
- Apply isolation procedures
- Work in varying weather conditions
- The names and functions of equipment, components and materials
- Equipment manufacturer's instructions and specifications
- Safe shifting and handling of tools and materials
- Statutory and regulatory authority requirements
- The nature of work undertaken at heights
- Heights safety systems
- The processes of providing for safe working practices
- Safety equipment/systems and considerations to facilitate working safely at heights
- Safe work methods
