Industry Training Qld (Provider Number 30477) Townsville offers Standard 11 Mine Induction (Surface Mining Only).

This programme consists of the following six nationally accredited units of competency (which are recognised by the QLD Department of Mines as the core S11 modules):

- RIICOM201E Communicate in the workforce
- RIIGOV201E Comply with site work processes/procedures
- RIIWHS201E Work safely and follow WHS policies and procedures
- RIIRIS201E Conduct local risk control
- RIIERR205D Apply initial response first aid
- RIIERR302E Respond to local emergencies and incidents

SUMMARY

- This nationally accredited course covers the skills and knowledge required to work in the coal mining industry.
- To complete the course, students must successfully complete the two-day course conducted here at Industry Training Qld – Townsville.
- Upon successful completion, the student will be issued with a statement of completion, a credit size card and a Standard 11 logbook to complete on a mine site. The student has 6 months to complete this logbook and return to Industry Training Qld to receive their full Statement of Attainment.

- USI NUMBER
- Closed in footwear
- 3 Forms of ID (1 CATEGORY A & 2 CATEGORY B OR 2 CATEGORY A & 1 CATEGORY B) One must be photographic and show a FULL NAME & D.O.B (See last page for types of relevant identifications)
- Students must be 18+ years of age
- Must be able to successfully complete an LLN (Language, Literacy and Numeracy) quiz

CERTIFICATION/VOCATIONAL OUTCOME

Upon successful completion of this course, the student will receive a partial completion certificate as well as a credit card size ID card. The participant can present this card at a recognising Queensland mine site and be site inducted. To gain the Statement of Attainment of Standard 11 - Surface, the participant is required to complete their logbook at the mine site and return to Industry Training Qld.

You are required to provide three **matching** original **evidence of your identity** (EOI) documents.
